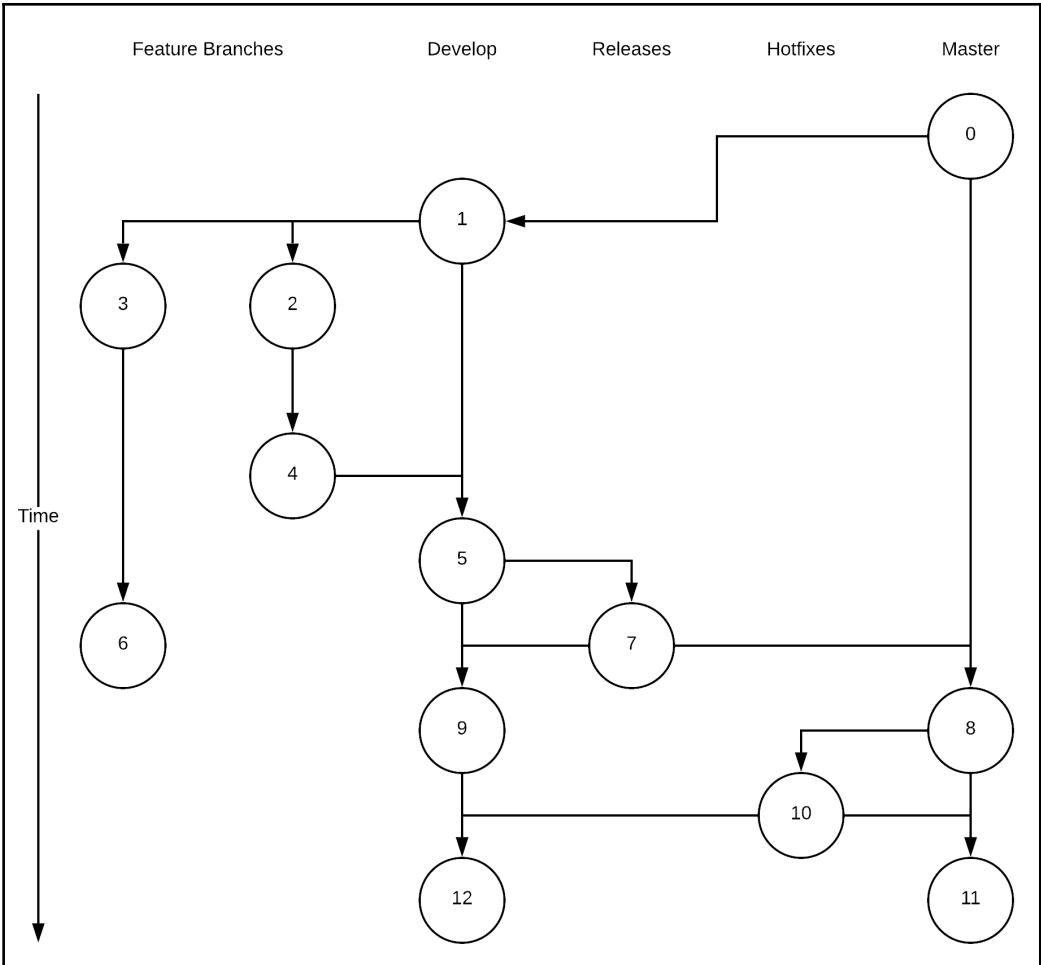


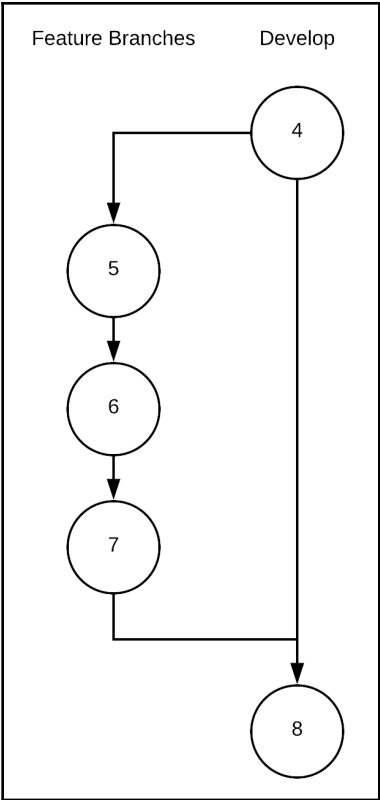


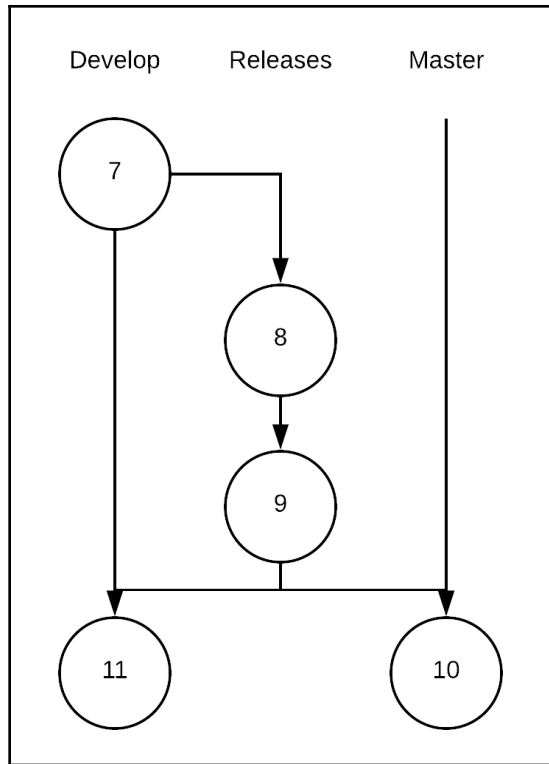


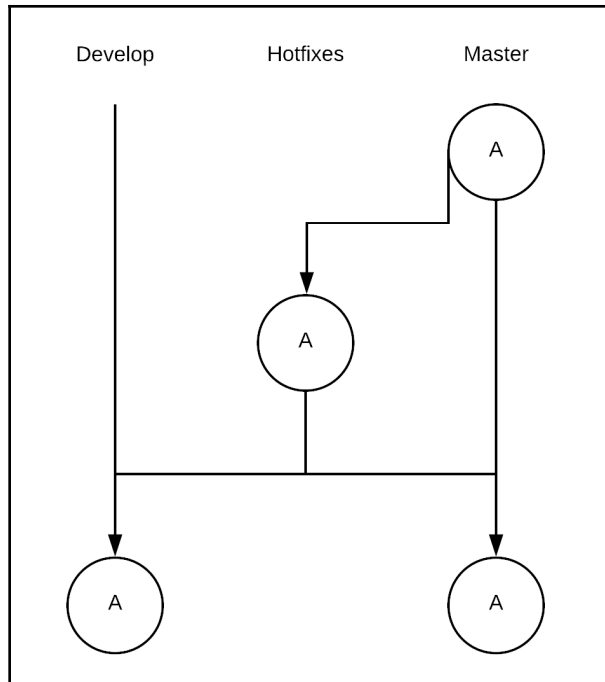


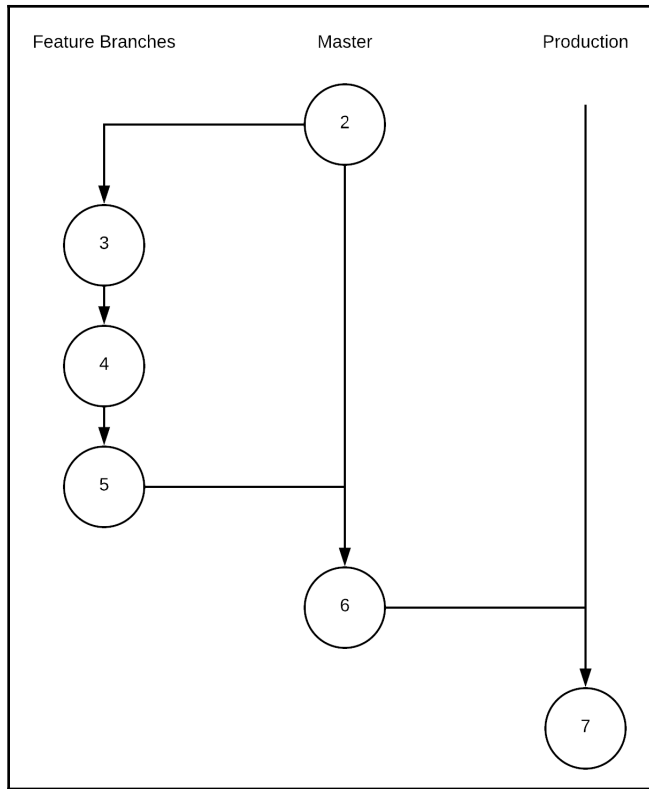


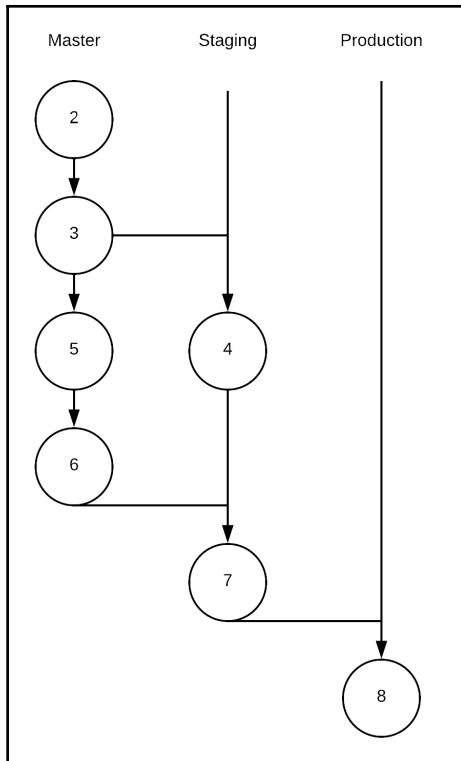


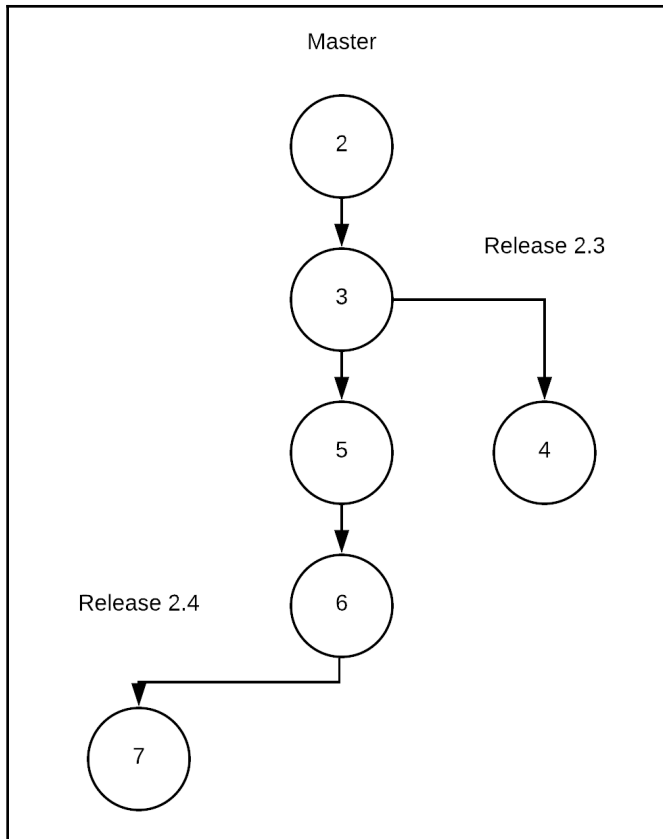


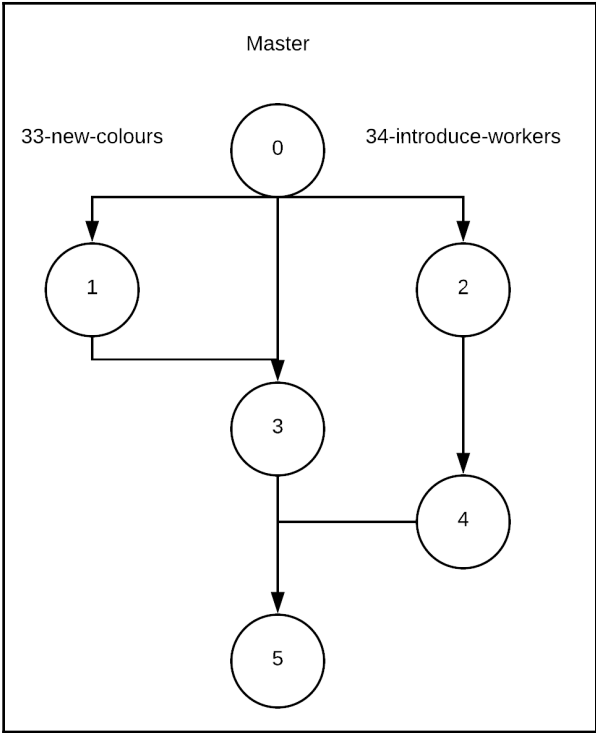












Chapter 4: Issues to Merge Requests
